

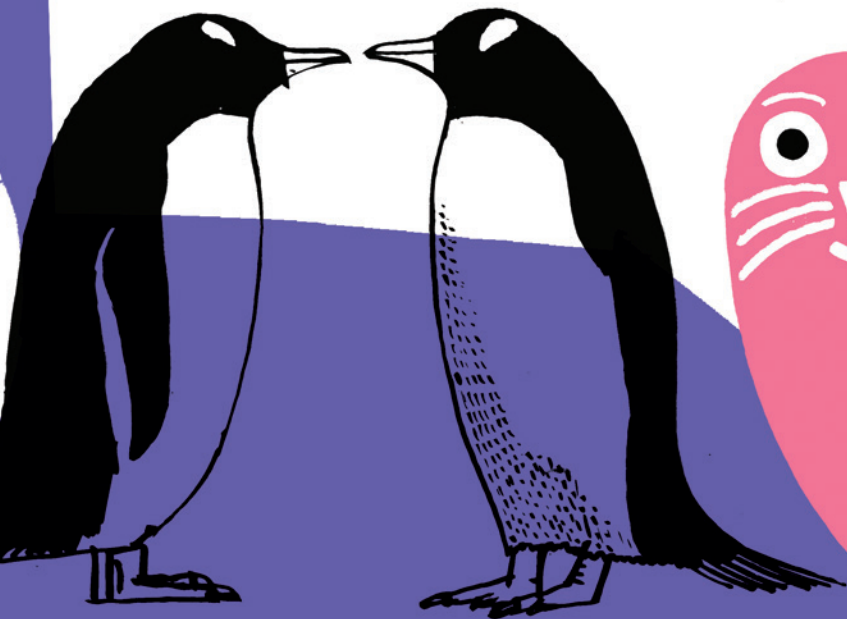

Today we're going to think about how we make changes to the natural world through our actions.

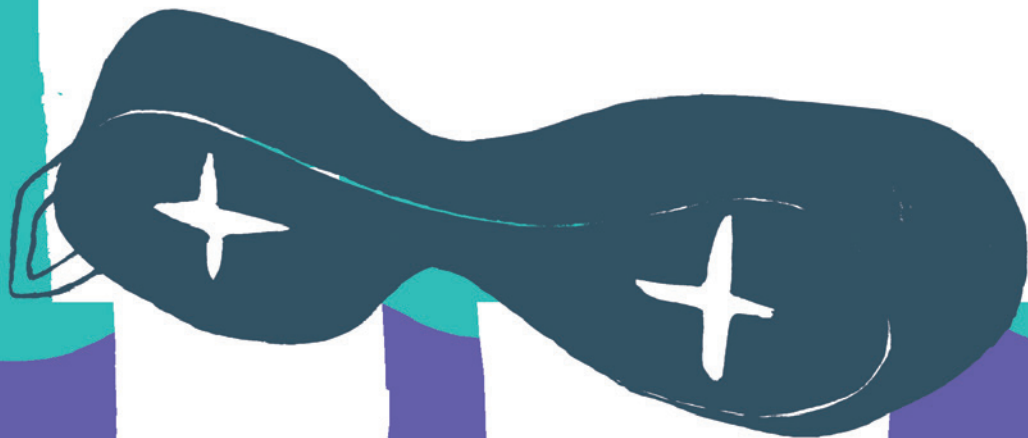

If you were visiting somewhere with extreme temperatures, what would you take with you?

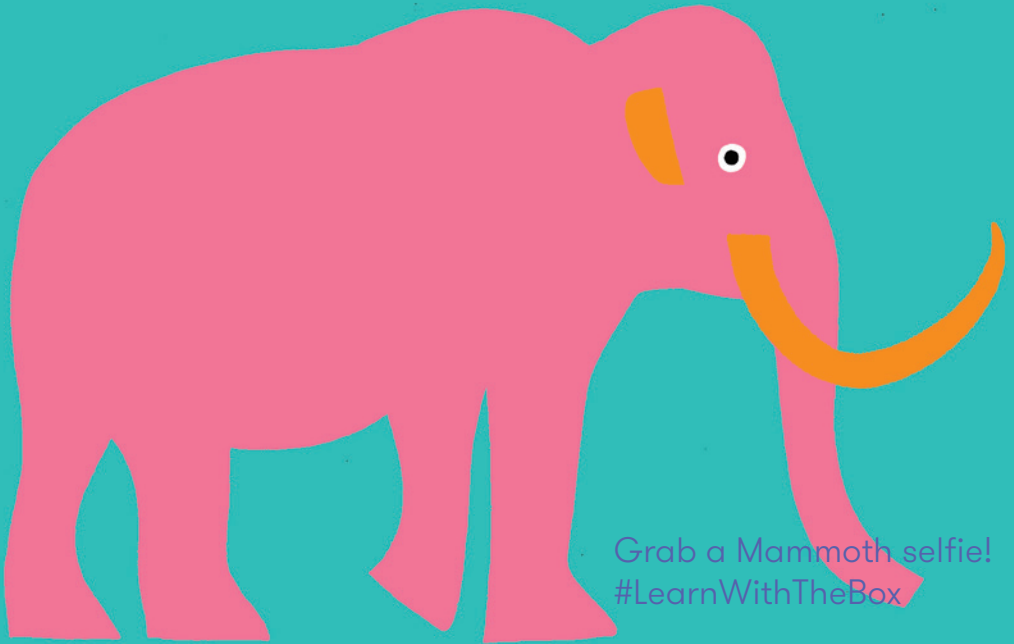

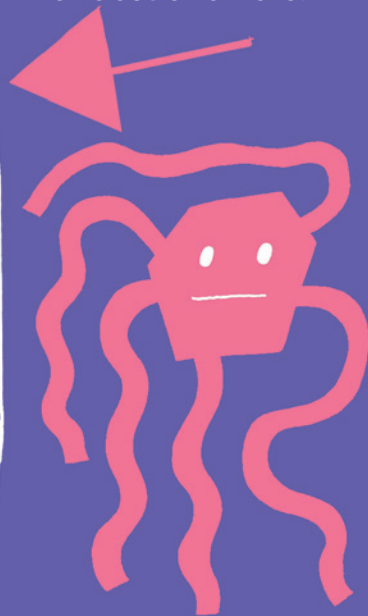

Some of these were collected by Marie Lebour, one of the first female scientists at the Marine Biological Association in Plymouth.



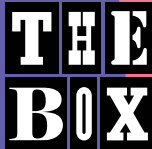
