Make your own Museum (Literacy)

Have you ever considered making your own museum? Now's the time to do it!

Select 10 objects in your household for a display. Think about why you want to display each object - why is it important to you, what story does it tell? Once you've selected your objects, think about how and where you're going to display them. Will they be displayed together, or will you leave them where they are?

Once you've found your objects, decide what you want people to know about them. You'll then need 10 pieces of card or paper to create a label for each object. Keep the information short - no more than 50 words per label. It's a challenge!

Once you've completed the labels invite other members of your household to explore your museum.
