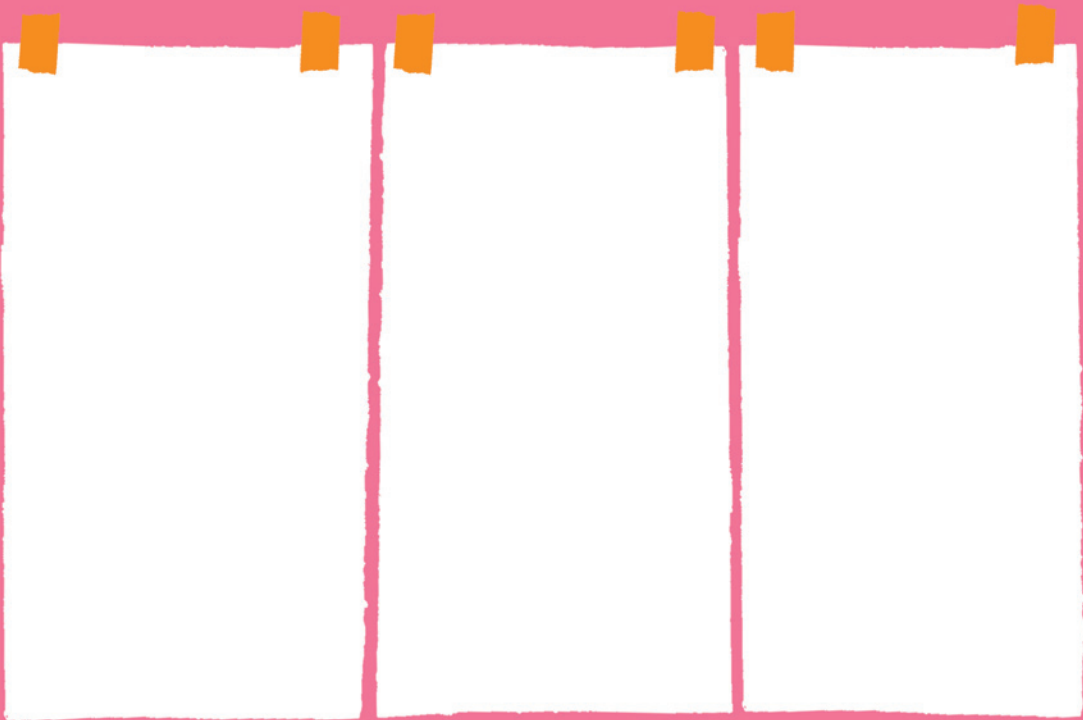

Plymouth. These pieces were all lost and found in Plymouth, many came from other parts of the world – can you find out where?





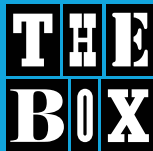
