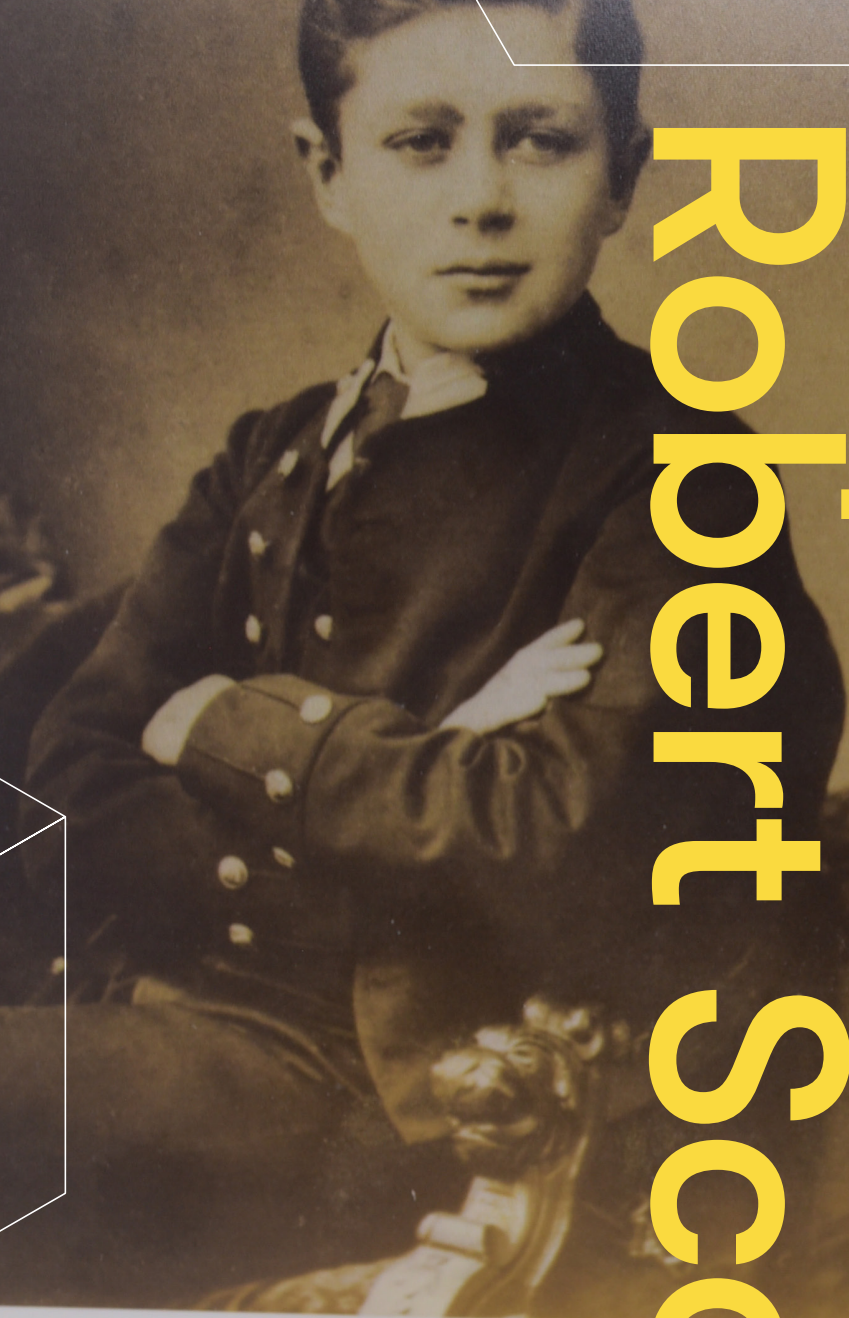

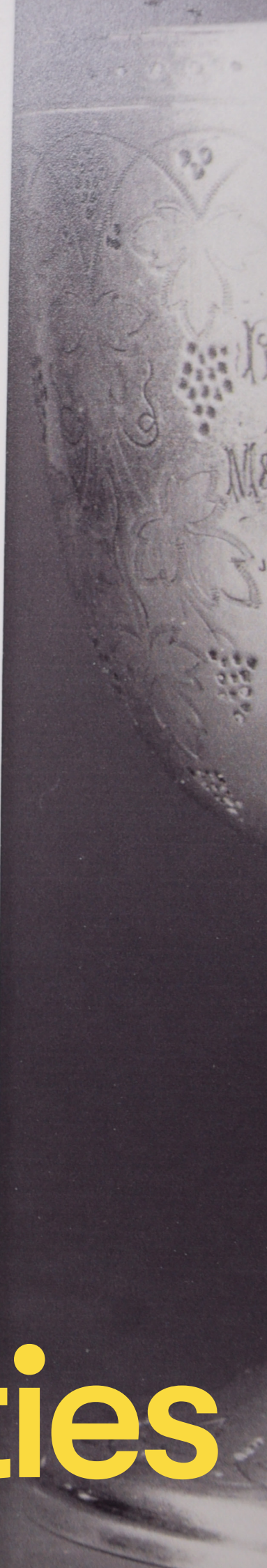
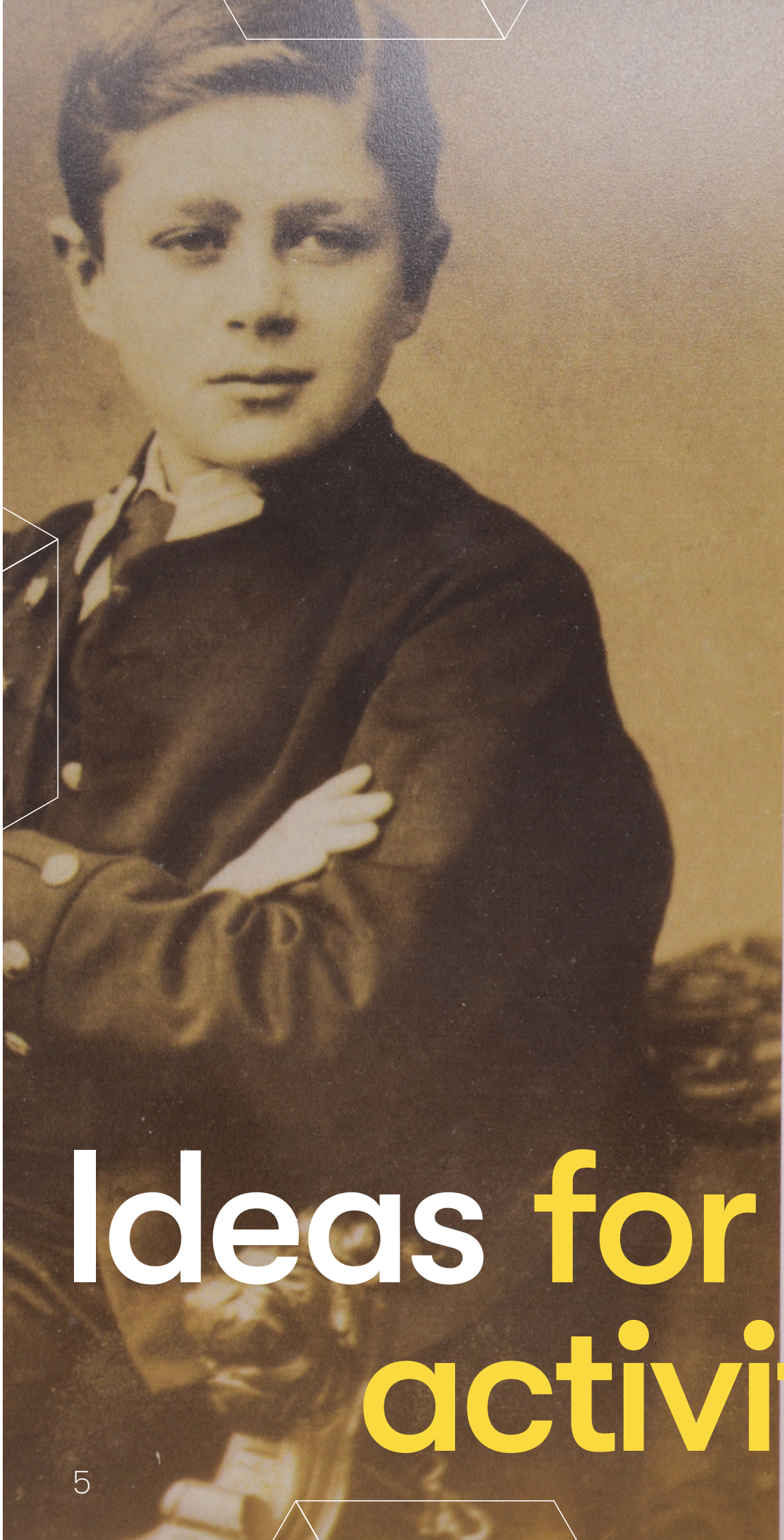

Ideas for activities

There are lots of different ways to use these objects with your class. Here's an idea to start you off:

1. Topic enhancer: research skills

Use the objects during the teaching of your topic, to enhance your teaching with a tangible experience.

Scott led two expeditions to Antarctica – the second of which was the ill-fated Terra Nova expedition from 1910-12. It was on the Terra Nova expedition that Scott and his five-man team tragically perished on their return journey from the South Pole.
