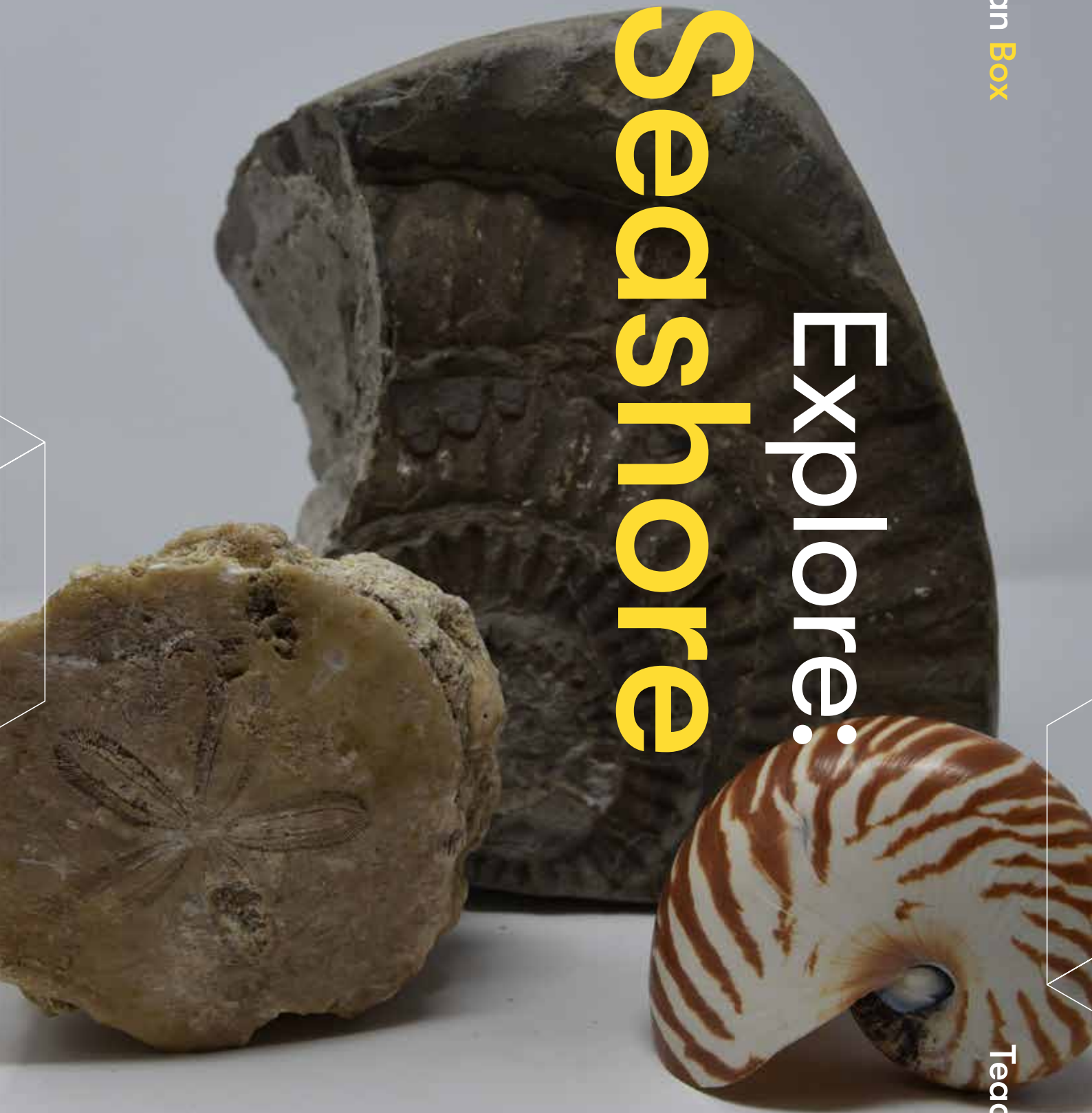

Ideas **for** **activities**

There are lots of different ways to use these objects with your class. Here's an idea to start you off:

1. How are they formed?

In this box you'll find three fossils and a close living relative - the Nautilus, a creature which has lived relatively unchanged for hundreds of millions of years.

Ask your class to research how fossils were formed in the sea. You can take this opportunity to discuss the rock cycle and ask which type of rock fossils are typically found in.
